STONEBRIDGE COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION PROGRAMS - FALL 2020

Here's a listing of what the Stonebridge Community Association will be offering this Fall.

Online sign up will begin Saturday, August 29th and end on Saturday, September 12th, 2020 at ourstonebridge.ca. A non-refundable membership fee of \$10 per family per year is required to participate in programs and must be purchased or presented at the time of program sign-up (memberships expire each year on July 31st). A fee of \$15 will apply to late registrations.

SCA honours other community association memberships. Cost-as-a-barrier assistance and/or KidSport applications are available for those facing financial hardships. FALL INDOOR SOCCER - U5, U7, U9

Registration for Indoor Soccer will run Saturday August 29 to Saturday Sept 12 online at ourstonebridge.ca.

Indoor Soccer Season runs October 18, 2020 to Dec 18 2020. Saskatoon Youth Soccer will schedule the games for U5, U7 and U9. The Stonebridge Community Association does not have control over the schedule.

Players will require shin guards, socks and shoes. A team jersey will be provided for the season.

There is no limit for on-time registrations however volunteer coaches are required. Please consider volunteering to coach. Certification for coaches is offered through Saskatoon Youth Soccer – any certification fees will be covered by either SYSI or the Community Association. We cannot offer our soccer program without a coach for each team. Registrations will be canceled and refunded if the team does not have a coach.
