Good day, neighbours!

I hope that everyone has been getting outside to enjoy the warmer weather. I want to give a huge thanks to our soccer coordinators, Eric and Terri Sanderson, for organizing the Stonebridge outdoor soccer program for both our kinder soccer and U5 to U9 teams - it's a lot of work, and they're doing an amazing job! I also want to acknowledge all the parents who have volunteered to coach their child's team - we would not be able to offer soccer without your help!

I wanted to let Stonebridge residents know about a construction project the City is planning this summer:

RECREATION AMENITY BUILDINGS PROJECT

In 2019, City Council approved funding for additional recreation amenities in Evergreen (Funk Park); Hampton Village (Al Anderson Park); Rosewood (Glen Penner Park); Stonebridge (Alexander MacGillivray Young Park); and Willowgrove (Wallace Park) neighbourhoods. This funding includes rink utility connections for Evergreen, Rosewood and Stonebridge community rinks. Depending on the site, additional support amenities could include some combination of washrooms, shade structures, storage and warm-up spaces.

Funding for these items were established through a Community Centre Levy first implemented in 2003 for Hampton Village and Willowgrove neighbourhoods; and subsequently implemented for Evergreen, Rosewood and Stonebridge neighbourhoods.

Our amenity building in Stonebridge will be built adjacent to our existing spray park in Alexander MacGillivray Young Park. The plan is for it to function as an activity space for the summer play progam, and also as a warm-up space for the community rink, which will be built adjacent to the amenity building. We're excited for this addition to our park, and we know it will get a lot of use! 

STONEBRIDGE COMMUNITY GARDEN 2021 UPDATE

The Stonebridge Community Garden is located in Peter Zakreski Park and consists of 33 plots (20 large, 13 small), 2 community plots, 2 raised beds, and a fruit garden. A small group of volunteers and many plot owners work hard to maintain the garden. The community garden continues to receive a lot of interest each year. All of our plots have been allocated for 2021 and we have 25-30 people on the waiting list. We will operate this year with COVID restrictions in place in accordance with what is outlined by the City of Saskatoon. This includes recommendations of mask use and social distancing while in the garden.

In early April, many of the gardeners worked hard to clean up the Peter Zakreski Park. The community garden received a grant of \$500 for this clean up from Eco Friendly Saskatchewan. These funds will go towards environmentally friendly projects in the garden, such as composting, attracting pollinators, and adding more native plants.

We plan to submit an application for a garden expansion this fall to the City of Saskatoon. This would create more garden plots and help address the high demand for plots in Stonebridge.
