ALL ABOUT FALL PROGRAM REGISTRATION

PROGRAMS ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE - VISIT OUR WEBSITE FOR THE LATEST (ourstonebridge.ca)

Online sign up will begin Monday, August 23rd and end on Wednesday Sept 8th, 2021 at ourstonebridge.ca. In-person payment drop-off will be held on Wednesday, September 8th, from 7:00PM-8:00PM at the Community Resource Centre at the Chief Whitecap/St Kateri Tekakwitha Catholic School Joint-use building—use Community Entrance.

A non-refundable membership fee of \$10 per family per year is required to participate in programs and must be purchased or presented at the time of program sign-up (memberships expire each year on July 31st). A fee of \$15 will apply to late registrations. Please consult the website (ourstonebridge.ca) for the latest program information. SCA honours other community association memberships as well. Cost-as-a-barrier assistance and/or KidSport applications are available for those facing financial hardships. 2021/2022 SASKATOON MINOR BASKETBALL

The SMBA is very excited to return to play in the fall of 2021!

The 2021/2022 Fall & Winter season runs mid-October to mid-March (with a break over Christmas) including playoffs for Mini division and up. There are no play-offs for Dunkaroos and Spuds with their seasons wrapping up mid-February.

Fall League games are on Saturdays at various high schools in the city and the league traditionally starts the Saturday following the Thanksgiving weekend.

Registration is run through the SMBA website, and all players must play in the community association where they live.

Dunkaroos: \$125/player Spuds: \$150.00/player

Mini: \$190.00/player Bantam: \$200.00/player

Junior: \$240.00/player Senior: \$280.00/player



Divisions:

Spud Basketball: for boys and girls (co-ed) who are IN GRADE THREE OR FOUR in the season of play. The teams play cross court and the coaches referee their own games.

Mini Basketball: for boys and girls who are IN GRADE FIVE OR SIX in the season of play. The teams play cross court and referees are provided. Mini A Pool teams play full court.

Bantam Basketball: for boys and girls who are IN GRADE SEVEN OR EIGHT in the season of play. No player in high school can play bantam ball. Teams play full court and referees are provided.

Junior Basketball: for boys and girls who are IN GRADE NINE OR TEN in the season of play. Players in this division may play even if they are on a high school team. Teams play full court and referees are provided.

Senior Basketball: for boys and girls who are under 19 years of age as of December 31 of the season in play or in GRADE 11 OR 12 (Players must be attending high school on a full-time basis). Players in this division may play even if they are on a high school team. Teams play full court and referees are provided.

Stonebridge is part of **Zone 5** when registering your team/player(s)! All teams are formed by the Community Associations in the city and they set the practice times as well. The SMBA does not form teams or set practice times. There will be no guarantee of getting on a team if you miss the online registration deadline of September 17th, 2021. To register, visit www.SMBA.ca!

Community teams practice once or twice a week, depending on the time available for teams. No league records are kept, and all teams that wish to enter the playoffs in the mini, bantam, midget and juvenile divisions may do so. Teams are formed by the community associations, and if one area does not have enough players, they can form teams with adjacent associations with permission from the SMBA.

KINDER SOCCER

Learning basic soccer skills while having fun! Coaches are needed - please consider signing up to coach when registering (no experience necessary). For kids born in 2018 & 2019. Choose either Tuesday 6pm – 6:45pm, Wednesday 6pm – 6:45pm, or Thursday 6pm – 6:45pm. INDOOR SOCCER: U5-U9

Registration for Indoor Soccer will run August 22nd to September 8th online at ourstonebridge.ca.

The indoor soccer season runs from October 17, 2021 to March 2022. Saskatoon Youth Soccer will schedule the games for U5, U7 and U9. The Stonebridge Community Association does not have control over the schedule. Practices are at the discretion of the coaches and will be scheduled by the coaches.

Players will require shin guards, socks and shoes. A team jersey will be provided for the season.

There is no limit for on-time registrations however volunteer coaches are required. Please consider volunteering to coach. Certification for coaches is offered through Saskatoon Youth Soccer — any certification fees will be covered by either SYSI or the Community Association. We cannot offer our soccer program without a coach for each team. Registrations will be canceled and refunded if the team does not have a coach.

Under-5 COED (Born in 2017): There are 15 (3v3) games played Sundays at Henk Ruys Soccer Center on hardcourt surface. Practices are TBD at coach's discretion. Cost \$130

Under-7 BOYS/GIRLS (Born 2015/2016): There are 15 (4v4) games played Sundays at Henk Ruys Soccer Center on hardcourt surface. Practices are TBD at coach's discretion. Cost: \$130

Under-9 BOYS/GIRLS (Born 2013/2014): There are 15 (5v5) games played Sundays at Henk Ruys Soccer Centre on hardcourt surface. Practices are TBD at coach's discretion. Cost: \$160

All teams will have the opportunity to play in Mini SISCO tournament which is held March 18 – March 20 on turf at Sasktel Soccer Center. Each team will be play 3 games and is included in the fees.


HIGH FITNESS


We're also actively looking for potential rink sponsors and partnerships!
