ART FOR KIDS

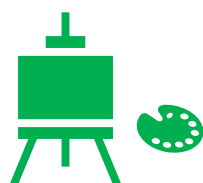

Practices are at the discretion of the coaches and will be scheduled by the coaches. Players will require shin guards, socks and either cleats or running shoes; a team jersey will be provided for the season. We do not have a limit for on-time registrations, but we do need coaches to volunteer for the number of teams/players registered. Please consider volunteering to coach!! We cannot offer our soccer programs without a coach for each team. Registrations will be canceled and refunded if the team does not have a coach.
