SPRAY PAD AND SUMMER PLAY PROGRAM

Cool off on your own time! All Spray pad locations across the city offer button-activated water play daily from 10:00 AM to 8:00 PM and will be open June 1st to September 4th, 2023.

Starting in June from Monday to Friday, spray pads located near school grounds are set to turn off 5 minutes before recess and lunch breaks and will resume 5 minutes after the breaks are over. Shut-off times will vary according to individual school schedules.


Please note that Spray Pads are not supervised outside of Play Program hours of operation.

SPRING PARK CLEAN-UP

Spring is here, which means City of Saskatoon workers are starting to ramp up maintenance activities for the more than 2,000 hectares of park and open spaces in Saskatoon. Seasonal workers start returning mid-April and the park clean-up process will continue until mid-May.

Spring Park maintenance activities include:

- Park clean-up, consisting mainly of litter control and removal of branches and leaves from turf areas and shrub beds.
- Pumping out the spring run-off in low-lying areas in parks and green spaces.
- Sweeping park-front sidewalks and boulevards where grass, trees and/or flowerpots are located. Full-size street sweepers will follow the same path after to collect the debris left behind on the road.
- Grooming of crusher dust trails in naturalized park areas to remove the ruts from run-off and other winter activities will begin once the trails have fully dried.
- Collecting litter and beginning of mowing cycles to over 400 hectares of open space areas along Circle Drive and other major freeways.
- Emptying of garbage receptacles will increase to at least once a week, beginning May 1.

How residents can help keep our parks clean and green:

- 1. Put litter in the trash cans provided throughout all parks.
- 2. Pick up after your pet.
- 3. Do not enter large puddles created by spring run-off.

WASTE & RECYCLING COLLECTION

Know your bins and collection day:

Garbage (BLACK bin) – Mondays

Recycling (BLUE bin) - Thursdays

Compost/organics (GREEN bin) - Mondays

*Bin collection is every two weeks!



Use the <u>Saskatoon Waste Wizard app</u> to check when your next bin collection day is and to check if an item should be put into your blue, green or black cart, or if it's appropriate for drop off as hazardous waste.

Items in BLACK or BLUE are NOT acceptable for your new green cart:
